QUESTION	ANSWER
<b>ACTIVITIES</b>	
What counts?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Anything listed on your Division's Activity sheet.</li><li>2. Any Activity designated to a Division <u>above</u> yours.</li><li>3. Any literacy activity assigned by your teacher as homework or part of some other reading program, i.e. MS Read-a-thon, etc.</li></ol>
What doesn't count?	Anything <b>not</b> listed above. Not sure? Email <a href="mailto:info@greatliteracyrace.ca">info@greatliteracyrace.ca</a>
How often?	As often as you like. The more you do the further your team goes each week!
How many?	One or many or all.
<b>SIGN-UP</b>	
How to register / sign up?	Your teacher signs-up your class to form a team.
Who can log-in?	Your school principal controls your school's account and holds the username and password. He / she will designate one Race Manager for the Race.
How do I know if my child's class is signed-up?	If you received the Great Literacy Race materials, with parent information, Activity Sheet and Tally Sheet, your class is signed-up.
<b>TALLY SHEET</b>	
How do we travel kms in the Race?	Do <b>any</b> Activity on your sheet to travel the kms in that category.
Tallying	Add up your family's kms every Sunday night.
Submission	Hand in your Tally Sheet to your child's teacher every Monday or Tuesday.
Getting more Tally Sheets	Your school office has master documents to print more Tally Sheets.

Uploading kms online	Your school volunteer Race Manager is responsible for getting your team's combined weekly kms online <b>every week</b> .										
<b>PRIZES</b>											
How does our class team get prizes?	Teams can become eligible for a class prize <b>EACH WEEK</b> by traveling the minimum kms to reach the weekly landmark. Check your team's score on the Team Scores page weekly to track your progress.

How do we find out?	Check your team's scores online every week to track progress.										
What are the landmarks?	Check online each week to find out!										
How does the qualifying class team collect its weekly prizes?	Prizes are delivered to each class every week via school courier.										
What if our class team does Not get the minimum kms needed to reach a weekly landmark?	Don't panic! Though your team will <i>not</i> get a prize for <u>that one week</u> , you can still be eligible for the <u>next week's</u> prize by reaching the next landmark. <b>Example:</b> if your team reaches the week #1 total of 260kms in the first week, but misses the week #2 total of 560kms in the second week, you can catch up by reaching the week #3 total of 740kms in the third week.										
Are there other prizes?	<p>YES!</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Every participant is entered in a draw for a new bike and helmet.</li> <li>2. The school with the highest % of participants gets a prize.</li> </ol>										
How do we qualify for the <b>Grand Prize</b> ?	ALL teams completing the Race by traveling the <b>minimum 1300kms</b> to reach the Final Race Destination will be entered in the Grand Prize draw.										
When do we find out who won the final prizes?	The draws will take place on Thursday, March 4 <sup>th</sup> . All schools will be										

	notified by email regarding the prize winners.
Wrap-Up	Prizes will be awarded at the Wrap Up party on Wednesday, March 10 <sup>th</sup> 2010 at 6:30pm at Terry Fox PS in Cobourg
